Dear Lori Cole:

I received your letter dated September 27, 2024, on behalf of New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (together, the Companies) requesting an extension of time to file the tariff amendments required by Ordering Clause 31 of the Commission’s *Order Establishing Updated Energy Storage Goal and Deployment Policy* (Order), issued June 20, 2024, in the above-referenced proceeding. Ordering Clause 31 states, in relevant part, that the Companies are required to “file tariff amendments necessary to effectuate the recovery of costs associated with the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority Bulk, Residential and Retail storage programs ... as discussed in the body of this Order.”

You state that the Companies are requesting additional time, and you note that the Companies have discussed the need to make this request with the Department of Public Service staff.

Please be advised that an extension, until October 17, 2024, is granted to New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation to comply with the Ordering Clause 31 of the Order. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of this proceeding, and this ruling will be posted on the Department’s website.
