CASE 01-T-1363 - Notice of Intent Filed by Pennsylvania General Energy, Corp. to Construct a Fuel Gas Transmission Line, Approximately 28,610 feet of 10 inch and 2,400 feet of 6 inch Pipeline, Located in Towns of Catlin and Big Flats, Chemung County.

NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS

(Issued July 2, 2025)

On November 28, 2001, pursuant to Public Service Law (PSL) §121-a(3) and(7), the Public Service Commission (Commission) granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) to a predecessor of Repsol Oil & Gas USA, LLC (Certificate Holder), authorizing, construction of a natural gas transmission line in the Towns of Catlin and Big Flats in Chemung County. On August 24, 2005, the Commission granted an amendment to the Certificate (2005 Amendment), as relevant here, authorizing the Certificate Holder to move an existing compressor station to the Town of Caitlin and construct an additional compressor station such that three compressor stations were authorized at the Town of Caitlin site (Caitlin Compressor Station).

In a petition filed on June 10, 2025 (Amendment Petition), the Certificate Holder requests a further amendment that would authorize it to downsize the Caitlin Compressor Station (Caitlin Compressor Station Upgrade).
