The parties shall serve by email each party and the Presiding and Associate Examiners with initial and reply briefs, and shall file same with the Secretary, by no later than 4:30 p.m. on the deadlines noted above.

Any request to change or extend the foregoing briefing schedule shall be made to the Presiding and Associate Examiners in writing, on notice to all parties, at least five days prior to the deadlines noted above. The request shall identify the parties that consent or do not object to the change/extension and the parties opposing same.
