Dear Ms. Audunson:

I received your letter dated September 26, 2022, on behalf of Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., New York State Electric & Gas Corporation, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid, Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc., and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (collectively, the Joint Utilities), requesting an additional extension of time comply with the directives set forth in the Commission's *Order Adopting Distributed System Implementation Plan Guidance* (DSIP Order), issued April 20, 2016, in Case 14-M-0101. The Order directed the Joint Utilities to individually file Distributed System Implementation Plan (DSIP) Updates and Benefit-Cost Analysis (BCA) Handbook Updates (collectively, 2022 DSIP Updates) on a biennial basis. An extension to December 30, 2022, was granted on March 23, 2022.

In your letter, you state that based on continuing consultation with Department of Public Service Staff (DPS Staff), and the need to align the DSIP process with the local transmission

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distribution planning process initiated in the Case 20-E-0197,¹ you are requesting an extension until June 30, 2023, to complete the filing. You advise that the Joint Utilities will continue to work closely with DPS Staff on the developments in Case 20-E-0197 to ensure that the 2022 DSIP Updates address the intended information needs and provide a strong alignment between planning at both the transmission and distribution levels.

Based upon the information provided, an extension is granted until June 30, 2023, to Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., New York State Electric & Gas Corporation, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid, Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc., and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation to individually file their 2022 DISP Updates. This extension is granted in order to promote the fair, orderly and efficient conduct of this proceeding. This ruling will be posted on the Department's website.
