Dear Jeffrey Rosenbloom,

I received your April 11, 2025 letter, on behalf of New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (together, the Companies), requesting an extension of time to comply with Ordering Clause 9 of the *Order Regarding Long-Term Natural Gas Plan and Directing Further Actions* (Order), issued and effective January 23, 2025, in the above-referenced proceeding.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 9, the Companies were directed, in relevant part, to convene a technical conference to develop criteria for identifying potential segments of infrastructure for strategic decommissioning and file a report on the conference within 30 days thereafter. You state that the Companies held a technical conference and, based on the discussions during that conference, they propose to hold another such conference on April 29, 2025. Accordingly, the Companies request an extension until May 29, 2025, to file the report summarizing the discussions and results of the technical conference.

Based on the information you have provided, an extension, until May 29, 2025, is granted to New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation to comply with the directive to file the report that is required pursuant to Ordering Clause 9 of the Order. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
