CASE 25-S-0741 - Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. for Steam Service.

RULING ON PARTY STATUS AND SCHEDULE

(Issued December 23, 2025)

MICHAEL CLARKE, Administrative Law Judge:

A procedural conference addressing party status and schedule, among other matters, was held in this proceeding on December 17, 2025. The conference was attended by representatives of Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Ed); trial staff of the Department of Public Service; the City of New York; the New York Energy Consumers Council, Inc.; UtiliSave, LLC; and the Utility Intervention Unit, Division of Consumer Protection of the New York State Department of State.

Party Status

No opposition to the participation of any of the above entities as parties was expressed during the procedural conference. While some of these entities have party status as of right,¹ I find that the others are likely to contribute to the development of a complete record. Accordingly, by this ruling, I confirm that all are granted party status. I likewise grant party status to Consumer Power Advocates and Brooklyn Navy Yard Cogeneration Partners, L.P., neither of which made an appearance at the conference, but whose requests for party status are unopposed.

Future requests for party status will be treated as motions, and all entities seeking party status will be provisionally added to the party list. If no objection is timely raised by another party or by me, party status may be assumed to be conferred.

Prior to the conference, Con Ed provided a proposed litigation schedule, which is adopted as follows.
