ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AMENDMENTS ON A PERMANENT BASIS

(Issued and Effective October 21, 2025)

BY THE COMMISSION:

INTRODUCTION

On December 2, 2024, Consolidated Edison Company of
New York, Inc. (Con Edison or the Company) filed amendments to
its electric and gas tariff schedules, P.S.C. No. 10 -
Electricity, P.S.C. No. 12 - Electricity, and P.S.C. No. 9 -
Gas, as required by the Commission's 2023 Rate Order issued in

these proceedings.¹ The Company's proposed amendments became effective on a temporary basis on January 1, 2025, and effectuate the rates and terms for Rate Year (RY) 3, the 2025 calendar year, of the three-year rate plans adopted by the 2023 Rate Order.

By this Order, the Commission authorizes the tariff amendments and statements listed in the Appendix to become effective on a permanent basis as of the date of issuance of this Order. Tariff provisions filed by Con Edison for the Standby Service Order,² which impact similar leaves as addressed in these proceedings, will remain in effect on a temporary basis until acted upon by the Commission.³

BACKGROUND

The 2023 Rate Order adopted the terms of the Joint Proposal and established a three-year rate plan for electric and gas service for the period beginning January 1, 2023, through

December 31, 2025.⁴ The approved rate plans provide for a RY 3 increase to electric delivery revenues of approximately \$457.5 million, or 5.8 percent, and a RY 3 increase in gas delivery revenues of \$187.2 million, or 8.6 percent.

The 2023 Rate Order directed Con Edison to file, on not less than 30 days' notice, electric and gas tariff amendments, as necessary, to effectuate the RY 3 terms to become effective on January 1, 2025, on a temporary basis. The amendments set forth in the compliance filings would not become effective on a permanent basis until approved by the Commission.

TARIFF FILINGS

On December 2, 2024, Con Edison filed amendments to its electric and gas tariff schedules to implement the RY 3 terms as required in the 2023 Rate Order. The proposed tariff amendments became effective on January 1, 2025, on a temporary basis. The Company complied with the requirements of newspaper publication pursuant to Public Service Law (PSL) §66(12)(b) and Title 16 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations (NYCRR) §720-8.1 for its December 2, 2024 filings. The Appendix to this Order sets forth a list of the tariff amendments the Company has filed and the dates of newspaper publication. In the 2023 Rate Order, the Commission directed parties wishing to comment on the tariff amendments to file such comments with the Secretary to the Commission within ten days of service of the tariff amendments.⁵ No comments were filed in response to Con Edison's compliance filings.

LEGAL AUTHORITY

Pursuant to PSL §§5, 65(1), 66(1), and 66(12), the Commission has the legal authority to review the proposed tariff leaves, as well as modify, reject, or approve such filed tariffs to ensure that the rates and services governed by those tariffs are just and reasonable and otherwise consistent with law. As such, the Commission has the legal authority to review and approve tariff amendments on a permanent basis, as prescribed in this Order.

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION

Con Edison's proposed tariff amendments properly reflect the terms and provisions approved in the 2023 Rate Order. Therefore, by this Order, the Commission authorizes the tariff amendments listed in the Appendix to become effective on a permanent basis as of the date of issuance of this Order. This Order does not address amendments to tariff provisions proposed by Con Edison in compliance with the Standby Service Order, and those proposed tariff provisions shall remain in effect on a temporary basis until acted upon by the Commission.

The Commission orders:

1. The tariff amendments filed by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. and listed in the Appendix to this Order are authorized to become effective on a permanent basis on the date of issuance of this Order, except for tariff provisions related to Case 15-E-0751, which shall remain in effect on a temporary basis until acted upon by the Commission.

2. These proceedings are closed pending compliance.
