CASE 22-T-0351 - Petition of New York Power Authority relating to its Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Y-49 345kV Transmission Facility - Formerly Case 70365.

NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS

(Issued May 12, 2025)

On May 18, 1988, the Public Service Commission (Commission) granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) to the Power Authority of the State of New York d/b/a New York Power Authority (NYPA), authorizing, subject to conditions, the construction and operation of the Y-49 Sound Cable Project (the Project). The Project is a 345 kilovolt (kV) submarine transmission cable that connects Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc.'s 345 kV Sprain Brook Substation, in Westchester County, to the Uniondale Hub Substation (formerly, the Long Island Power Authority's (LIPA) East Garden City Substation) in Nassau County. The Commission granted the Certificate pursuant to Public Service Law (PSL) Article VII.

In a petition filed on April 17, 2025, pursuant to PSL Section 122(4) (Amendment Petition), NYPA requests a Certificate amendment that would authorize it to expand the Uniondale Hub Substation by constructing a new 345 kV substation on an adjacent gravel parking lot owned by LIPA. The new 345 kV substation will be in a fully enclosed building, located in the Village of Garden City and the Town of Hempstead.
