Dear Stephanie McDermott:

I received your November 1, 2024 letter, on behalf of Department of Public Service staff (DPS staff), requesting additional time to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clauses 2 and 3 of the Commission's *Order Instituting Proceeding* (Order), issued April 18, 2024, in the above-referenced proceeding.

You note that Ordering Clause 2 directs DPS staff to develop and file a Grid Flexibility Study consistent with the directives in the body of the Order, with input from stakeholders, by November 15, 2024, while Ordering Clause 3 directs DPS staff to develop and file the first iteration of the Grid of the Future Plan by December 31, 2024. You state that DPS staff is working to complete these filings but needs additional time.

Please be advised that extensions are granted to DPS staff (1) until January 31, 2025, to file a Grid Flexibility Study as required by Ordering Clause 2 and (2) until February 28, 2025, to file the first iteration of the Grid of the Future Plan as required by Ordering Clause 3 of the Order. These extensions are granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
