Re: Case 20-E-0197 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission to Implement Transmission Planning Pursuant to the Accelerated Renewable Energy Growth and Community Benefit Act.

Dear Secretary Phillips,

New York Power Authority (NYPA) hereby requests a one-month extension of time, from August 9, 2026 to September 9, 2026, to file comments in response to two Notices published in the State Register on June 10, 2026, and related to the above-captioned matter. The first stated that the Public Service Commission (Commission) is considering the results of the Cycle 1 Report from the Coordinated Grid Planning Process (CGPP) and whether there is any transmission need driven by a Public Policy Requirement.¹ The second notice stated the Commission is considering the Report, which includes recommendations to approve development of local transmission projects.²

The Report and the requests for comments raise significant and complex issues that require additional time for stakeholders to adequately address. Moreover, last week, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) issued its Short-Term Assessment of Reliability (STAR) Report, which provides additional information that could be relevant for the Commission's consideration. Since this NYISO STAR Report has just been released, stakeholders have not had an opportunity to review the material and compare its findings to those made in the Cycle 1 Report. The Commission's decisional process would be aided if additional time were provided to stakeholders to properly review the materials, evaluate conclusions drawn, and complete thorough comments.
