CASE 24-E-0540 - Petition of Abundant Solar Power Inc. for a Declaratory Ruling Regarding a Standardized Interconnection Contract with New York State Electric & Gas Corporation.

NOTICE EXTENDING RESPONSE DATE

(Issued October 4, 2024)

On September 20, 2024, Abundant Solar Power, Inc. (Abundant) filed a petition seeking a declaratory ruling that its project be restored to the interconnection queue by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (NYSEG) upon the execution of an interconnection contract. Abundant asserts that its 101 Vienna Rd Unit 2 project was removed from the interconnection queue by NYSEG due to a communications issue that was not its fault. Citing 16 NYCRR §3.3(a), Department of Public Service staff requested an extension 16 NYCRR §8.2(c)'s 21-day timeframe for responding to declaratory rulings, asserting that the extension would promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
