**NOTICE OF SELF-CERTIFICATION OF
EXEMPT WHOLESALE GENERATOR STATUS**

Pursuant to the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 2005 (“PUHCA 2005”),¹ and section 366.7² of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC” or “Commission”), Soltage Maspeth ESS, LLC (“Applicant”) hereby submits this notice of self-certification as an exempt wholesale generator (“EWG”), as defined in section 366.1 of the Commission’s regulations.³

II. DESCRIPTION OF APPLICANT

Applicant is developing and will own and operate a 20 MW / 80 MWh stand-alone battery energy storage project that will be located in Maspeth, Queens, New York (the “Facility”). The Facility will consist of a battery energy storage system (“BESS”) and associated facilities and equipment necessary to charge the BESS and discharge energy from the BESS. The Facility will also include limited and discrete interconnection facilities necessary to effectuate wholesale power sales from the Facility.

The Facility is expected to reach commercial operation in the second quarter of 2028. The Facility will be located in the New York Independent System Operator balancing authority area in the Northeast region and will be interconnected to the transmission system owned and operated by Consolidated Edison of New York, Inc. Applicant will seek authorization from the Commission to make sales of energy, capacity, and ancillary services at market-based rates.

III. REPRESENTATIONS REGARDING EXEMPT WHOLESALE GENERATOR STATUS

- a. Applicant will be engaged directly and exclusively in the business of owning or operating, or both owning and operating, all or part of one or more eligible facilities and selling electric energy at wholesale.
- b. The Facility is an “eligible facility” because (i) it will be used for the generation of electric energy exclusively for sale at wholesale; and (ii) it includes only those interconnecting transmission facilities that are necessary to effect a sale of electric energy at wholesale.
- c. No rate or charge for, or in connection with, the construction of the Facility, or for electric energy produced by the Facility (other than any portion of a rate or charge which represents recovery of the cost of a wholesale rate or charge), was in effect

under the laws of any state on October 24, 1992. Therefore, no determinations by a state commission are necessary for this self-certification to become effective.

- d. No portion of the Facility will be owned or operated by an electric utility company that is an affiliate or associate company of Applicant, as defined in section 366.1 of the Commission's regulations.
- e. Applicant may be engaged in certain activities that are incidental to the generation of electric energy for sale at wholesale to the extent permitted by the Commission. Specifically, Applicant may be engaged in the sale of ancillary services and renewable energy credits ("RECs") associated with the electricity produced by the Facility. The Commission has determined that the sale of ancillary services and RECs associated with an eligible facility are activities incidental to an EWG's business of owning and operating an eligible facility and selling electricity at wholesale.⁴
- f. There are no lease, license, or similar incidental arrangements involving the Facility pursuant to which Applicant will receive any revenues.

As required by section 366.7(a) of the Commission’s regulations, a copy of this self-certification has been filed with the New York Public Service Commission, the state commission of the state in which the Facility is located.

For the reasons set forth in this notice of self-certification, Applicant satisfies the requirements of EWG status.
