Dear Mr. Carley,

Pursuant to the Public Service Commission's (Commission) *Order Authorizing Utility Energy Efficiency and Building Electrification Portfolios Through 2025* (the Order),¹ the New York Utilities² and the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA), collectively the Program Administrators, are required to update and refile the Statewide Low- to Moderate-Income Portfolio Implementation Plan (Statewide LMI Implementation Plan or the Plan) in the event substantive changes are required. The Order calls for the Director of the Office of Markets and Innovation (OMI) to issue a letter of approval confirming compliance of the Plan with the provisions set forth in the Order or a letter of denial with justifications and options to remedy.

Further, as identified in the Director of the OMI's February 16, 2023 approval letter, Program Administrators were directed to ensure alignment of the information presented in the

Statewide LMI Implementation Plan and all other relevant filings³ and to clearly identify Commission authorized budgets, targets, and any allowable shifts in budgets and targets.

The Statewide LMI Implementation Plan was filed on November 1, 2023. The filing has been reviewed by the Department of Public Service staff (Staff) for compliance. Staff finds that the Statewide LMI Implementation Plan is generally consistent with the provisions of the Order as well as guidance provided in the Director's February 13, 2023, approval letter.
