The 150,000 square foot mall complex will house these three vital centers. The eShops will offer consumer electronics products and services; the Marketplace proposes retail shops, including ladies' and men's apparel, gifts, books, housewares, and a food court. The Culture Gallery promises the rediscovery of one's own heritage and experience of the arts and crafts of different cultures.

Peter Wu, senior vice president, director of Leasing, feels that eSquare will be the location where East meets West in a spectacular new town center. "We believe a coordinated effort to develop this old warehouse district into an economically viable center for businesses and the community is necessary for the future success of Flushing as a whole," he said.

A waterfront site is also envisioned in the future to house residential, retail, and community educational facilities.

In 1998 the Department of City Planning rezoned Flushing into C4-2 and C4-3 categories, turning the area into the largest commercial district within six miles, allowing major opportunities to build shopping and retail centers comparable to those in Nassau and other counties.

Space is now available for leasing at the mall, scheduled to be completed in the summer of 2001. The Open House will be held at 133-15 39th Avenue from 5p.m. to 7 p.m.

Queens Goes To Washington D.C.

Three Queens council members were in our nation's capital this week, to meet with New York members of Congress to discuss plans to retain federal money for Queens to lessen school overcrowding and cut the number of flights at Queens airports.

Called the Federal Legislative Agenda Breakfast, local Council Speaker Peter Vallone and Queens council members Michael Abel and John Sabini along with four other council members from across the city attended.

The elected officials met with the Congressional delegation at the all-day meeting to discuss what Queens and the rest of the city needs from the 2002 federal budget. Although the breakfast is an annual event, those in attendance said this year's is crucial.

"There is a new administration in place along with a Republican controlled House and Congress, and all of the New York representatives are democrats," explained Jake Linn, spokesperson for the city council from Washington D.C.

"It's going to be an uphill battle this year for money for New York, and that's why we need a united front. That's what we're working on down here."

The final federal budget is expected to be complete sometime this summer.

It has worked well for Juan Lopez, a doctor who specializes in luggage. Representing the Luggage Dr. Repair Center in East Elmhurst, he was eager to meet with American Airlines, who is taking over TWA.

"We met Olympic Airways last year," said Lopez, and his local repair center struck a deal with Olympic Airways at JFK. When a passenger flies Olympic and finds that their luggage is damaged, it goes to the doctor. Now, the repair center is hoping to infiltrate

for potential tenants and the general public. Refreshments will be served. A Broker's reception will take place from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., and a buffet lunch will be served.

LaGuardia Airport.

Dolores Hofman, director of the QASDO, said the free event helps boost the economy of Queens by employing local businesses.

Dan Jennings, president of Sir Speedy, a copy and printing company in Jamaica, told the *Tribune*, "I'm just trying to find a buyer."

Although Sir Speedy is a franchise, the brand recognition is not as effective as in Long Island and he was hoping to meet some potential clients at the networking session. It worked for him three years ago when he met a client at the event.

"I left them some information and they called nine months later about hanging up signs in the terminal [at JFK] and since then we've had a good relationship," he said.

Huan Ham of Star Mountain Coffee and a South Ozone Park resident said, "We're trying to break into the aviation industry."

Star Mountain is a coffee grower, roaster and retailer with a store in Cargo Building 8 at JFK. They grow their own beans in Honduras. Ham said he is trying to get a better spot at the airport to sell his coffee. Fortunately for him he had the first table at the door of the event.

Bryan Smolarz, a director at Kings Pest Control in Forest Hills, explained getting clients, "is a very slow process."

He said that the event is providing an avenue for the businesses to meet face to face. After attending the event for seven years, Smolarz said that he has had great success, landing several contracts, particularly at food facilities.

Why Poppies?

To The Editor:

As it has been a custom for years, if you give a donation to the American Legion a few weeks before Memorial Day, you receive a little red paper poppy in return.

One of the most asked questions is, "Why Poppies?" The answer is that poppies only flower in churned-up soil. Their seeds can lie on the ground for years, but will sprout only when someone roots up the ground. Poppies, common in Europe, sprouted in profusion in the battlefields of the Western Front during World War I. These fields now hold the bodies of thousands of the men who gave their lives there.

In May 1915, before the United States entered the war, Canadian Major John McCrea wrote one of the most memorable war poems ever written as poppies blossomed around him.

The major was no stranger to writing, having authored several medical texts besides dabbling in poetry. As a surgeon he spent weeks treating injured men - Canadians, British, Indians, French and Germans - in the fierce fighting of the Ypres salient. Sitting on the back of an ambulance parked near a dressing station, Major McCrea scribbled the following poem (first two verses).

In Flanders Fields

In Flanders fields the poppies blow
Between the crosses, row on row,
That mark our place; and in the sky
The larks, still bravely singing, fly
Scarce heard amid the guns below.

We are the Dead, Short days ago
We lived, felt dawn, saw sunset glow,
Loved, and were loved, and now we lie
In Flanders fields.

Today, American Legion poppies are assembled by disabled, needy and aging veterans in Veterans Administration hospitals. Proceeds go toward these veterans and to maintain veterans' rehabilitation and service programs.

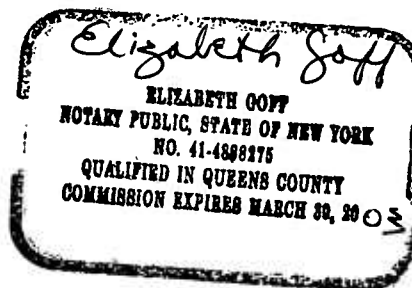
