Dear Mr. Post:

I received your January 24, 2023 letter, on behalf of Verizon New York Inc. (Verizon), requesting that the deadline for filing its 2022 Annual Report be extended from March 31, 2023, until May 25, 2023.

You state that Verizon's regulatory team is responsible for preparing and filing over 300 reports annually in New York and in other states, with most of them due between January 1 and April 15. You explain that the financial data that provides the basis for the reports is not available until late January, making it difficult to meet the March 31 filing date. You add the report is voluminous and extraordinary effort is required to complete the necessary compilation, analysis, and review that is required prior to its filing.

Based upon the information you have provided, an extension until May 25, 2023, is granted to Verizon New York Inc. to file its 2022 Annual Report with the Commission. This extension is granted in order to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
