CASE 22-T-0654 - Petition of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need Pursuant to Article VII for its Lockport-Batavia Line 112 Rebuild Project in Niagara and Genesee Counties.

NOTICE OF JOINT PROPOSAL AND OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

(Issued June 4, 2024)

On April 29, 2024, a Joint Proposal, signed by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the Company), trial staff of the Department of Public Service, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, and the New York State Department of Agriculture & Markets was filed in the above-referenced case. The Joint Proposal contains the terms, conditions, practices, and guidelines recommended by the signatory parties for inclusion in a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need that would authorize the Company to rebuild 21.7 miles of the existing 35-mile long, 115 kilovolt Lockport-Batavia Line 112 transmission line located in the Towns of Lockport, Royalton, and Alabama, in Niagara and Genesee Counties (Rebuild Project). The Rebuild Project would replace the existing single-circuit, steel tri-leg "aeromotor" transmission line towers with new single-circuit galvanized tubular steel pole structures. Six segments of the existing transmission line will be affected, requiring new operational and related easements for the Rebuild Project.
