CASE 26-G-0384 - Petition of The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY and KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid for Authorization to Permit their Existing Base Tariff Rates to Remain in Effect During the Year Ending March 31, 2028 and Other Related Relief.

NOTICE ESTABLISHING COMMENT DEADLINE

(Issued June 23, 2026)

The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY and KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid (together, National Grid) filed a proposal on May 29, 2026, requesting an extension of current base rates through the year ending March 31, 2028, and other related relief. The filing proposes to use tracking mechanisms to defer incremental costs of net utility plant, depreciation expenses, property taxes, uncollectibles, and the city/state construction program for future recovery from ratepayers; to implement a surcharge to allow recovery of deferred costs related to property taxes and site investigation and remediation activities; and to lower current targets for leak-prone pipe replacement and leak backlogs.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that stakeholders and other interested entities are invited to file comments concerning National Grid's proposal to extend current rates. Comments are requested by **August 24, 2026**. Please be advised that untimely comments may not be considered by the Commission.
