Dear Natara Feller:

I received your letter dated July 3, 2024, on behalf of New York Retail Choice Coalition (NYRCC) requesting a further extension of time to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clauses 3, 4, 6, 7 and 9 of the Commission's *Declaratory Ruling and Order on Rehearing*, issued April 18, 2024, in the above-captioned proceedings. By *Notice Extending Deadlines*, issued on June 10, 2024, a previous extension, until July 31, 2024, was granted.

In your letter, you reiterate that NYRCC intends to commence a proceeding pursuant to Article 78 of the Civil Practice Law and Rules challenging the Commission's decisions, and you renew your June 3, 2024 request for an extension of time to comply with the directives noted above until 60 days after the court has issued a ruling on the anticipated Article 78 Petition. In the alternative, you request an additional extension, until August 31, 2024.

No new or persuasive justification is provided in your July 3, 2024 request that would warrant granting an additional extension with respect to complying with these directives. Accordingly, please be advised that your request for an additional extension is denied.
