

## **National Grid Standby Service Opt-In Report for Calendar Year 2023**

Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the “Company”) is providing the following responses to the information requests posed in Ordering Clause No. 4 of the New York Public Service Commission’s *Order on Standby and Buyback Service Rate Design and Establishing Optional Demand-Based Rates* issued May 16, 2019 in Case 15-E-0751 – In the Matter of the Value of Distributed Energy Resources. The information provided is regarding calendar year 2023.

### **1 - Customer participation in optional Standby Service rates by parent service classification**

The Company had zero customers opt-in to optional Standby Service rates in 2023.

### **2 - Bill impact on non-participating customers within each service classification**

With no customers opting into the optional Standby Service rates in 2023, there was no bill impact on non-participating customers in 2023.

### **3 - Provide notice to the Commission in the event more than two percent of the aggregate load within a single service classification migrates to optional Standby Service Rates.**

With no customers opting into the optional Standby Service rates in 2023, the two percent aggregate threshold was not met in 2023. The Company will provide notice to the Commission if this changes before the next annual reporting requirement.
