Regarding Natural Gas Service to Electric
Generators.

NOTICE SEEKING COMMENTS

(Issued February 7, 2024)

On February 6, 2024, Department of Public Service staff (Staff) filed the Staff Revised Proposal on Electric Generator Rate Design (Revised Proposal) in this proceeding. The Revised Proposal updates and modifies the Staff Proposal on Electric Generator Rate Design (Initial Proposal) filed in this proceeding on March 30, 2020, and the Staff Supplemental Proposal on Electric Generator Rate Design (Supplemental Proposal) filed on August 17, 2021. The Initial, Supplemental, and Revised Proposals are collectively referred to as the Proposals. Together, the Proposals recommend a rate design for gas delivered to electric generators with a nameplate generation capacity of at least five megawatts that includes an Access Charge, a Demand Charge, and a Volumetric Charge. The Proposals also present recommendations regarding balancing requirements and charges, cost recovery of lost and unaccounted for gas, and negotiated contracts between gas utilities and electric generators. Finally, the Proposals recommend implementing a transition charge, where necessary, to mitigate the impacts of the changes in rate design to generators and other gas ratepayers.
