### NOTICE OF PUBLIC STATEMENT HEARING AND PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

The New York State Public Service Commission ("Commission") will hold a public statement hearing concerning the request of the Village of Hamilton, on behalf of its Hamilton Municipal Utilities Commission, for authorization to construct gas plant and exercise franchises in the Towns of Eaton, Hamilton and Madison in Madison County, New York. The Commission's goal is to obtain public feedback on the petitioner's proposal. A procedural conference will be held immediately following the public statement hearing for the parties to discuss further procedural steps in this proceeding, particularly the need for evidentiary hearings.

The public statement hearing will be held will be held as follows:

It is not necessary to be present at the start of the hearing or to make an appointment in advance in order to speak. Persons interested in speaking will be asked to complete a card requesting time to speak when they arrive at the hearing, and will be called in the order in which the cards are received.

Speakers are not required to provide written copies of their comments.

The public statement hearing will be held open for a minimum of one hour, and will be kept open until every one wishing to speak has been heard or other reasonable arrangements have been made. A verbatim transcript of the hearings will be made for inclusion in the record.
