On August 7, 2025, Nexamp, Inc. and 14 of its affiliated project companies (collectively, Nexamp) filed a complaint in this proceeding against Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (National Grid). The complaint was filed pursuant to Section I, Part C, Step 11 of the Standardized Interconnection Requirements (SIRs). In its complaint, Nexamp contests National Grid's attempt to invoice additional interconnection costs as part of the final reconciliation process. Nexamp asserts that National Grid has failed to comply with the timelines under the SIRs, provide cost estimates in good faith, communicate cost increases prior to incurring increased costs, and justify the costs included in final reconciliation invoices.
