



ORES DMM Matter Number 23-03015 - Application of WEB ADDISON SOLAR, LLC, for a Major Renewable Energy Facility Siting Permit Pursuant to Article VIII of the New York State Public Service Law to Develop, Design, Construct, Operate, Maintain, and Decommission a 105-Megawatt (MW) Solar Energy Facility Located in the TOWNS OF ADDISON, CAMPBELL, and ERWIN, STEUBEN COUNTY.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FILING AND
AVAILABILITY OF LOCAL AGENCY ACCOUNT FUNDING

(Issued May 7, 2026)

On May 6, 2026, WEB Addison Solar, LLC, filed an application pursuant to Public Service Law article VIII seeking a siting permit to develop, design, construct, operate, maintain, and decommission the Addison Solar Project with a nameplate generating capacity of up to 105 megawatts (MW) in the Towns of Addison, Campbell, and Erwin, Steuben County. The May 6, 2026, application filing commenced the 60-day application completeness review pursuant to 16 NYCRR 1100-4.1 by the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (ORES or Office).

The facility is proposed to be located on 1,082 acres and include the installation and operation of photovoltaic (PV) solar panels and their rack/support systems; direct current (DC) collection lines and communications cables connecting the arrays to inverters; the inverters with their support platforms, control electronics, and step-up transformers; buried and overhead AC medium voltage collection lines; security fencing and gates around each PV array; gravel access roads; temporary laydown areas; medium voltage to transmission voltage collection substation with associated equipment and fenced areas; overhead transmission 115-kV lines to connect the collection substation to the point-of-interconnection (POI); a new POI switchyard; and any other improvement subject to ORES jurisdiction. The facility is proposed to interconnect to the existing Stoney Ridge - Sullivan Park 115 kV electric transmission line and associated right-of-way owned and operated by New York State Electric and Gas.

With its application, WEB Addison Solar, LLC,

submitted the required local agency account fee of \$105,000.00. Please take notice that funds are available to eligible local agencies and potential community intervenors for use in contributing to the development of a complete record leading to an informed decision by the Office as to the appropriateness of the site and the facility, and for local agencies, for use in determining whether a proposed facility is designed to be sited, constructed, and operated in compliance with applicable local laws and regulations.

Local agencies and potential community intervenors intending to request local agency account funding must submit their request for funding by no later than **4:30 p.m. EST on June 8, 2026**. Parties requesting such funding must use the **ORES Request For Local Agency Account Funding** form available in the Resources section of the ORES website at: <https://dps.ny.gov/ores-resources>.

All requests for local agency account funding must register on the party list on the Department of Public Service's Document and Matter Management (DMM) system,¹ consent to electronic service, and electronically file (EFile) the funding request form. Any person unable to consent to electronic service may obtain authorization for alternative means of receiving service upon good cause shown to the assigned Administrative Law Judges (ALJ) Henry James Joseph (Henry.Joseph@dps.ny.gov) and Anthony Belsito (Anthony.Belsito@dps.ny.gov).
