CASE 22-G-0610 - In the Matter of a Review of the Long-Term Gas System Plan of National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation.

NOTICE EXTENDING COMMENT PERIOD

(Issued July 25, 2023)

By letter filed July 21, 2023, Earthjustice, Sierra Club, Natural Resources Defense Council, and Alliance for a Green Economy requested a three-week extension of the due dates for initial and reply comments concerning the substance of the final long-term plan that was filed by National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (NFG) on July 17, 2023 in this proceeding. The comments are currently due on August 24, 2023, and September 8, 2023, respectively.¹

Earthjustice, Sierra Club, Natural Resources Defense Council, and Alliance for a Green Economy state that they are engaged in multiple proceedings before the Commission for which submissions are due in late August or early September. They add that their requested extension will allow them the necessary time to develop robust comments on NFG's final long-term plan.

As mentioned in the July 19 Notice, stakeholders have had numerous opportunities to participate in the review of NFG's long-term plan, including stakeholder meetings and several opportunities to provide written comments. As a result, there is insufficient bases for granting a three week extension, and a more abbreviated extension will be granted instead.
