



ORES DMM Matter Number 23-03033 - Application of VALCOUR ELLENBURG NEWCO, LLC, for a Major Renewable Energy Facility Siting Permit Pursuant to Article VIII of the New York State Public Service Law to Develop, Design, Construct, Operate, Maintain, and Decommission a 91-Megawatt (MW) Wind Energy Facility Known as the Ellenburg Wind Repowering Project Located in the Towns of Ellenburg and Clinton, Clinton County, and the Towns of Bellmont and Chateaugay, Franklin County.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FILING AND
AVAILABILITY OF LOCAL AGENCY ACCOUNT FUNDING

(Issued July 22, 2025)

On July 21, 2025, Valcour Ellenburg NewCo, LLC, filed an application pursuant to Public Service Law article VIII seeking a siting permit to develop, design, construct, operate, maintain, and decommission the Ellenburg Wind Repowering Project with a nameplate generating capacity of up to 91 megawatts (MW) in the Towns of Ellenburg and Clinton, Clinton County, and the Towns of Bellmont and Chateaugay, Franklin County. The July 21, 2025, application filing commenced the 60-day application completeness review pursuant to 16 NYCRR 1100-4.1 by the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (ORES or Office).

The Ellenburg Wind Project is an existing 81 MW wind energy facility. The repowering process will include the installation of new, state-of-the-art technology to increase the generating capacity and extend the useful life of the facility. The project would consist of the installation and operation of up to 25 wind turbines, together with the associated electrical collection system, access roads, laydown/staging areas, and ancillary facilities. Up to 21 wind turbines are proposed to be located in the Town of Ellenburg, Clinton County, and up to 4 wind turbines are proposed to be located in the Town of Bellmont, Franklin County. The electrical collection system is proposed to pass through the Towns of Ellenburg, Bellmont, Clinton, and Chateaugay. The facility would use an existing collection substation in the Town of Clinton, point of interconnection switchyard, access roads, and other ancillary facilities.

With its application, Valcour Ellenburg NewCo, LLC, submitted the required local agency account fee of \$91,000. Please take notice that funds are available to eligible local agencies and potential community intervenors for use in contributing to the development of a complete record leading to an informed decision by the Office as to the appropriateness of the site and the facility, and for local agencies, for use in determining whether a proposed facility is designed to be sited, constructed, and operated in compliance with applicable local laws and regulations.

Local agencies and potential community intervenors intending to request local agency account funding must submit their request for funding by no later than **4:30 p.m. EST on Wednesday, August 21, 2025**. Parties requesting such funding must use the **ORES Request For Local Agency Account Funding** form available in the Resources section of the ORES website at: <https://dps.ny.gov/ores-resources>.

All requests for local agency account funding must register on the party list on the Department of Public Service's Document and Matter Management (DMM) system,¹ consent to electronic service, and electronically file (EFile) the funding request form.
