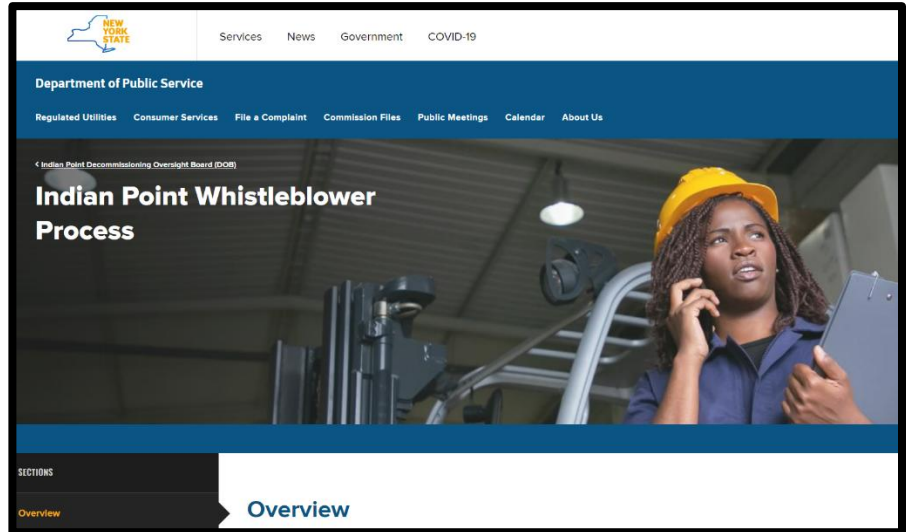

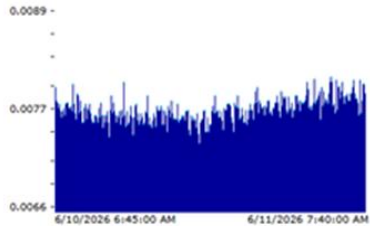

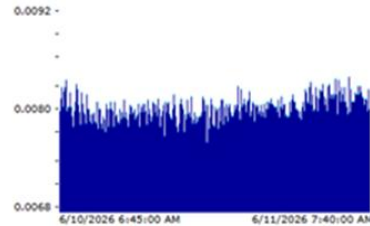
## RM-6 Trend

last 24 hours



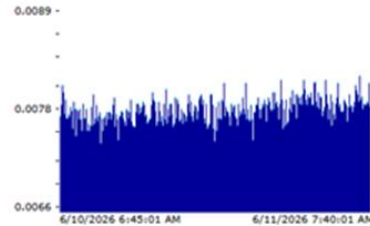
## RM-7 Trend

last 24 hours



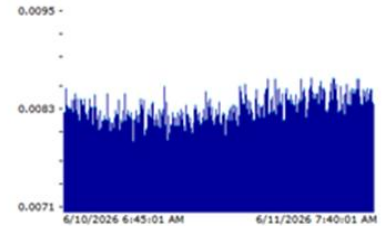
## RM-8 Trend

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# DPS Oversight Activities

- Agency staff reviewed the Annual Radiological Effluent and Environmental reports submitted to the NRC in April for Indian Point. No abnormalities were observed.



# DPS Oversight Activities

- State regulators have been present at Holtec monthly project meetings, and Holtec has provided the information required under the Joint Proposal at each meeting.
- Notable on-site observations:
  - NRC inspection activities week of 3/16.
    - Unit 1 Containment
    - Steam Generator Mausoleum
  - Unit 1 Switchyard/ superstructure demolition.



# DPS Oversight Activities

- 2021 Joint Proposal required minimum trust fund balances and financial and project reporting to New York State – stricter safeguards and oversight mechanisms than what is required by federal law
- State agencies (DPS, AG, DEC, NYSERDA) reviewed trust fund balances w/Holtec in Aug. 2021, Jun. 2022, Sept. 2022, Jun. 2023, Dec. 2023, Apr. 2024, Oct. 2024, April 2025, and November 2025.
- Holtec's March 2026 report to NRC on the status of decommissioning funding indicates that Holtec remains in compliance with its minimum trust fund balance obligations. State agencies will be reviewing that report with Holtec at a meeting later this month.

# DEC Oversight Activities: Consent Order

## Remedial Investigation Scoping Work Plan

- Approved by DEC on August 11, 2022 and updated by Holtec on May 9, 2024.

## Remedial Investigation (RI) Work Plans

- Investigations will be conducted in a series of RI Work Plans.
- Approved work plans will be announced via fact sheet distributed to the public.

# DEC Oversight Activities: Consent Order

## AOC 118 – IPEC LaFarge – former Spectra Construction Area

- NYSDEC approved the draft Remedial Investigation Work Plan on 10/23/2023.
- HOLTEC completed field work in May of 2024.
- HOLTEC submitted the Remedial Investigation Report fo NYSDEC on 8/29/2024.
- NYSDEC provided comments to HOLTEC on 7/15/2025.
- HOLTEC submitted revised report to NYSDEC on 8/19/2025
- NYSDEC provided a second round of comments on the revised report on 11/25/2025
- HOLTEC scheduled a call w/NYSDEC on 6/25/26 to discuss responses.
- No other Remedial Investigation Work plans have been submitted to NYSDEC



# DEC Oversight Activities – Facility Permits

- SPDES # NY0004472 – Governs Discharges from Main Facility
  - Expired on April 30, 2022. Holtec submitted a timely renewal application. Facility continues to have coverage under the existing SPDES permit pursuant to the State Administrative Procedure Law.
- SPDES #NY0250414 – Governs stormwater discharges from the Unit 2 transformer moat
  - Expired on March 31, 2023. Holtec submitted a timely renewal application. Facility continues to have coverage under the existing SPDES permit pursuant to the State Administrative Procedure Law.
  - After requests from the public, DEC held processing of this application in order to combine both SPDES permits.
- DEC has reviewed the permit application.
- DEC is awaiting a final court decision on the Save the Hudson litigation before providing a Draft SPDES Permit for public review and comment.
