Dear Sam Laniado and Zachary Perdek:

I received your letter dated February 22, 2023, filed on behalf of Eight Point Wind, LLC (EPW), requesting an extension of time to comply with Certificate Condition 66 of the New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment's (Siting Board) *Order Granting Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, With Conditions* (Order), issued August 20, 2019, in the above-captioned proceeding.

Certificate Condition 66 requires EPW to file the first Sound Compliance Test report eight months after the Eight Point Wind Project's (Project), commercial operation date, of February 8, 2023, and the second report no later than thirteen months thereafter. The first test report is currently due October 8, 2023, and the second report is due March 8, 2024. In your letter, you state that due to seasonal constraints, the expected time to obtain sufficient monitoring data and to compile the data into the reports in compliance with Certificate Condition 66 is not feasible. Therefore, you are requesting extensions until December 8, 2023, and June 8, 2024, respectively, to allow adequate time to conduct the tests and prepare the result reports.

Based on the information you have provided, extensions, until December 8, 2023, and June 10, 2024, respectively, are granted to Eight Point Wind, LLC to submit the First and Second Sound Compliance Test Reports, in accordance with the requirements of the Order. These extensions are granted in order to promote the fair, orderly and efficient conduct of this proceeding. This ruling will be posted to the Department's website.
