

Please identify the location and nature of any potential discharge that may result from the proposed project and the location of receiving waters (attached additional information as needed): The Clean Path New York (CPNY) Project is an approximately 178-mile-long transmission line facility that will run from the Fraser Substation in Delaware County to the Rainey Substation in Queens. Impacts to rivers along the submarine transmission line route will occur due to the following activities: (1) trenching and burial of the line, (2) armoring of the line where sufficient burial cannot be achieved, (3) dredging and backfilling of HDD exit pits at shore crossings, and (4) placement of anchors or spuds to position the work vessels. Please see the Joint Application for Permit for additional detail.

Please provide a description of any methods and means proposed to monitor the discharge and the equipment or measures planned to treat, control, or manage the discharge (attach additional information as needed): The Project will be constructed in accordance with the Spill Prevention and Control Plan, HDD Inadvertent Return Contingency Plan, and Best Management Plan Summary, which are provided in Attachment N (Construction Plans) of the Joint Application for Permit. Site-specific pollution control methods will be further detailed in the following site-specific plans to be prepared by the Applicant for each construction segment prior to construction: EM&CP, E&SC Plan, and SWPPP. 
