Dear Edward Sherwin:

I received your letter dated January 26, 2024, on behalf of Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the Company), requesting an extension of time to file the quarterly reports on its Electronic Deferred Payment Agreement (eDPA) program as required by Ordering Clause 2 of the Commission’s *Order Approving Electronic Payment Agreement Program* (Order), issued November 15, 2018. The filing is due January 30, 2024.

You state that the Company transitioned to a new billing system in October 2023, and the transition changed the methods of data collection for some of the data points in the eDPA Report. As a result, you are requesting an extension until February 29, 2024, to file the eDPA report for the fourth quarter of 2023. You advise that an extension will allow time for the review and validation of the data in the new system.

Based upon the information provided, an extension until February 29, 2024, is granted to Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. to file its eDPA report for the fourth quarter of 2023. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of these proceedings.
