CASE 23-G-0437 - In the Matter of a Review of the Long-Term Gas System Plan of New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation.

NOTICE ESTABLISHING COMMENT DEADLINE

(Issued May 21, 2024)

In its Order Adopting Gas System Planning Process, issued May 12, 2022, in Case 20-G-0131, the Public Service Commission (Commission) created a long-term gas system planning process for local gas distribution companies. Pursuant to that process, New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (the Companies) filed their initial long-term plan on October 2, 2023, their revised long-term plan on February 20, 2024, and their final long-term plan on April 26, 2024. Stakeholders had opportunities to participate in the review of the long-term plan (including attending stakeholder meetings and submitting information requests and written comments) throughout this process.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that initial comments from stakeholders and other interested entities concerning the substance of the Companies' final long-term plan are requested by **June 21, 2024**, with reply comments requested by **July 10, 2024**.
