Brief Explanation: The 867 MU \& 867 MIU currently has an optional segment REF*BLT to indicate the Bill Option (LDC or DUAL). This field needs to be changed to Required.

Detail Explanation: All utilities outside of New York who use EDI for data exchange indicate the bill option in the 867 Monthly Usage. New York's failure to do so has caused countless hours of researching accounts as well as customer dissatisfaction, particularly when a utility changes the bill option accepted on the Enrollment Response to another bill option without an EDI transaction.

In addition, when bill option changes occur, the utility may change the effective date without notice to the supplier, therefore causing another billing discrepancy. Having the bill option in the 867 transaction clearly identifies whether the utility is expecting to send/receive an 810 transaction.

The information is readily available in the utility systems and must be provided on the 867 Monthly Usage transaction (and 867 Interval Usage for ConEd) in order to ensure the customer is billed on time.
