ADDENDUM I TO POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT Between

New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Cornell University

This Addendum 1 (the "Addendum 1") effective as of January 1, 2018 (the "Addendum 1 Effective Date") is issued under and supplements the Power Purchase Agreement between New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") and Cornell University with an effective date of January 1, 2017 (the "Agreement").

If there is a conflict between the terms and conditions stated in this Addendum 1 and the Agreement, the terms and conditions in this Addendum 1 shall govern. All capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined shall have the same meaning given them in the Agreement.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Agreement expires on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire by way of mutual written agreement to amend the Agreement to extend the term.

NOW, THEREFORE, NYSEG and Cornell University agree as follows:

1. ARTICLE 1. TERM is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
