NOTICE EXTENDING COMMENT PERIODS

(Issued July 24, 2024)

In its Order Adopting Gas System Planning Process, issued May 12, 2022, in Case 20-G-0131, the Public Service Commission created a long-term gas system planning process for local gas distribution companies.¹ As part of that process, on June 3, 2024, The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY, KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid, and Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (collectively, the Companies) filed their initial long-term plan in this proceeding. Pursuant to the Notice of Technical Conference and Establishing Comment Deadlines issued June 4, 2024 (June 4 Notice), comments from stakeholders and other interested entities concerning the substance of the Companies' initial long-term plan are requested by August 19, 2024, with reply comments requested by September 3, 2024.

In a letter filed on July 22, 2024, Sane Energy Project requested a 45-day extension of the August 19 comment date. Sane Energy Project states that an extension will allow additional time to research with experts and solicit members' insights to develop a comprehensive and equitable plan that serves the best interests of the community. On July 23, 2024,

the City of New York filed a letter supporting Sane Energy Project's extension request. It adds that the extension will also give stakeholders time to coordinate with each other on issues of common interest and will allow for interested persons to digest relevant information filed in this and other proceedings.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the extension requests are granted, in part. The dates by which initial and reply comments from stakeholders and other interested entities concerning the substance of the Companies' initial long-term plan are hereby extended as follows: until **September 18, 2024**, for initial comments, with reply comments now requested by **October 3, 2024**.
