ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AMENDMENTS ON A PERMANENT BASIS

(Issued and Effective May 18, 2026)

BY THE COMMISSION:

INTRODUCTION

On March 2, 2026, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation
d/b/a National Grid (Niagara Mohawk or the Company) filed tariff
amendments to its electric and gas tariff schedules as directed
by the Commission's 2025 Rate Order.¹ The Company's tariff
amendments, which became effective on a temporary basis on

April 1, 2025, effectuate the rates for Rate Year (RY) 2 (April 1, 2026, through March 31, 2027) of the three-year rate plans established by the 2025 Rate Order.

By this Order, the Commission authorizes the tariff amendments listed in the Appendix to become effective on a permanent basis upon the issuance of this Order. The tariff amendments filed by Niagara Mohawk regarding the Standby Service Order, Urgent Upgrade Order, and Rehearing Order,² will remain in effect on a temporary basis until acted upon by the Commission.³

BACKGROUND

The 2025 Rate Order adopted the terms of the Joint Proposal establishing three-year electric and gas rate plans that provided annual revenue requirement increases.⁴ For RY 2, after levelization, the 2025 Rate Order authorized a revenue increase of \$297.4 million for the Company's electric business and a revenue increase of \$64.5 million for its gas business.

The 2025 Rate Order directed Niagara Mohawk to file electric and gas tariff amendments, as necessary, to effectuate the terms for RY 2, on not less than 30 days' notice and to take effect on a temporary basis on April 1, 2026. The Commission directed parties wishing to comment on the compliance filing to do so with the Secretary to the Commission within 14 days of service of the Company's proposed tariff amendments.⁵ The 2025 Rate Order stated that the tariff amendments set forth in the compliance filings would not become effective on a permanent basis until approved by the Commission.

TARIFF FILINGS

On March 2, 2026, Niagara Mohawk filed tariff amendments to its electric tariff schedules, P.S.C. Nos. 214 - Electricity and 220 - Electricity, and to its gas tariff schedule, P.S.C. No. 219 - Gas, to effectuate the rates for RY 2, pursuant to the Commission's 2025 Rate Order. The tariff amendments became effective on a temporary basis on April 1, 2026.

The Company complied with the requirements of newspaper publication pursuant to Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and Title 16 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations §720-8.1 for its filing made on March 2, 2026. The Appendix to this Order sets forth a list of the tariff amendments filed by the Company and the dates of newspaper publication.

COMMENTS

Several comments have been received since Niagara Mohawk filed its tariff amendments to effectuate RY 2. Generally, the comments have expressed concern regarding affordability. No

comments were received in regard to the substance of the filed tariff revisions and their compliance with the 2025 Rate Order.

LEGAL AUTHORITY

Pursuant to PSL §§5, 65, 66(1), and 66(12), the Commission has the legal authority to review the proposed tariff leaves, as well as modify, reject, or approve such filed tariffs to ensure that the rates and services governed by those tariffs are just and reasonable and otherwise consistent with law. As such, the Commission has the legal authority to review and approve the Company's tariff amendments on a permanent basis, as prescribed in this Order.

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION

The Company's proposed tariff amendments, filed March 2, 2026, properly reflect the terms and provisions of the 2025 Rate Order, including the rates and charges necessary to effectuate RY 2. While we acknowledge the comments received expressing concern regarding affordability, the tariff amendments we address in this Order merely effectuate the rates the Commission previously reviewed and determined to be just and reasonable in the 2025 Rate Order. Our action in this Order is limited solely to ensuring the tariff amendments do comply with the directives of the 2025 Rate Order. We further note that no comments assert that the tariff amendments do not comply with the 2025 Rate Order.

Because the filed tariff changes appropriately implement the directives of the 2025 Rate Order, the Commission authorizes the tariff amendments listed in the Appendix effectuating RY 2 to become effective on a permanent basis upon the date of issuance of this Order. However, this Order does not approve on a permanent basis the amendments to tariff

provisions proposed by the Company in compliance with the Standby Order, the Urgent Upgrade Order, or the Rehearing Order. Those tariff provisions shall remain in effect on a temporary basis until acted on by the Commission in one or more subsequent orders.

The Commission orders:

1. The tariff amendments filed by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid that are listed in the Appendix to this Order, are authorized to become effective on a permanent basis, upon the date of issuance of this Order.

2. Tariff provisions, filed in compliance with the Commission orders issued October 13, 2023, in Case 15-E-0751; issued June 12, 2025, in Case 24-E-0364; and issued November 14, 2025, in Cases 25-M-0248 et al., shall remain in effect on a temporary basis, until acted upon by the Commission.

3. These proceedings are continued.
