Re: Case 24-E-0364 - Proactive Planning for Upgraded Electric Grid Infrastructure.

Dear Amy Davis and Marina Chu:

I received your letters dated November 8, 2024, on behalf of New York State Electric & Gas Corporation, Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation, and Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation (collectively, the Companies) requesting an extension of time to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clause 1 of the Commission's *Order Establishing Proactive Planning Proceeding*, issued August 15, 2024, in the above-referenced proceeding. Ordering Clause 1 directs the utilities to file proposals for Urgent Upgrade Projects (UUP proposals) by November 13, 2024.

You state that the Companies have engaged with other utilities and the Department of Public Service (DPS) staff to complete their specific UUP proposals, but you add that additional time is needed to complete the work that is associated with the requisite filings. You note that the Companies have notified DPS staff of this request and have received no objection.

Please be advised that an extension, until November 27, 2024, is granted to New York State Electric & Gas Corporation, Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation, and Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clause 1. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of this proceeding, and this ruling will be posted on the Department's website.
