CASE 25-T-0749 - Petition of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid for an Amendment to a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need issued in Case 26729.

NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS

(Issued December 15, 2025)

On December 30, 1976, the Public Service Commission (Commission) granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate)¹ to Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (National Grid) authorizing construction of an 11.4 mile overhead 115 kilovolt transmission facility in Allegany County from the then existing Wellsville Tap structure No. 209 to the then existing transmission line angle structure No. 201 located in the Village of Andover. In a petition filed December 4, 2025 (Amendment Petition), pursuant to Public Service Law Section 122(4), National Grid requests an amendment to the Certificate. If approval is granted, Certificate Condition 3 would be modified to allow for the use of steel replacement structures, instead of wood poles.
