NOTICE ANNOUNCING TECHNICAL CONFERENCE

(Issued August 30, 2024)

In response to the Public Service Commission's (Commission) Order Directing Energy Efficiency and Building Electrification Proposals, issued on July 20, 2023, in the above-captioned cases, the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority and the State's large electric and gas utilities (collectively, the Utilities),¹ filed proposals on November 1, 2023. These proposals, which address years 2026 through 2030, contain, among other things, funding targeting the electrification of space and water heating for New York's building stock, including homes and buildings in the Low- to Moderate-Income (LMI) market segment. The Department of Public Service is interested in further exploring areas that the Commission should consider in the development of an LMI energy efficiency and building electrification strategy, including, but not limited to, addressing energy affordability and consumer protections, the appropriate leveraging of various funding

sources and programmatic offerings, and approaches to customer outreach and education.
