Dear Kara Krueger,

I received your letter dated March 1, 2023, on behalf of The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY and KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid (collectively, the Companies), requesting an extension of time to submit their annual Residential Methane Detection Programs (the RMD Programs) status report as required by the Commission's *Order Approving Joint Proposal, as Modified, and Imposing Additional Requirements* (Order), issued August 12, 2021, in the above-referenced proceedings.

In your letter, you state that the Companies have made progress towards distribution of residential methane detectors but due to continued gas sensor supply chain issues resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, they need additional time to distribute RMDs under the annual RMD Programs. You therefore are requesting an extension until September 30, 2023, to distribute RMDs under the RMD Programs. You advise that the Companies have informed Department of Public Service Gas Safety staff (DPS Staff) of the supply chain issue, and state that the Companies will continue to update DPS Staff with any significant delays as the Programs and shipments progress.
