Case 22-T-0547 - Application of Anbaric Development Partners, LLC, Pursuant to Public Service Law Article VII for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Hera Power Link Transmission.

NOTICE INVITING COMMENTS

(Issued December 21, 2023)

On November 1, 2023, Anbaric Development Partners, LLC (Applicant) filed an application pursuant to Public Service Law (PSL) Article VII for authority to construct, own, and operate the Hera Power Link, a proposed transmission system that will connect one or more offshore wind generators to Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc.'s transmission system at either its Gowanus Substation or its proposed Clean Energy Hub, both in Brooklyn, New York. On September 30, 2022, the Applicant filed a petition seeking waivers of certain Public Service Commission regulations governing the content of PSL Article VII applications; more specifically, the following provisions of Title 16 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR):

1) Section 86.3(a)(1), to allow the use of maps produced by the National Geospatial Program of the United States Geological Survey (USGS) instead of New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) maps, thereby reducing the width of the area in which resources must be shown from five miles to one mile for terrestrial segments; and to allow the use of nautical charts published by the United States Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) for the submarine portions of the proposed project, thereby reducing the

width of the area in which resources must be shown from five miles to 1,000 feet for submarine segments;

2) Section 86.3(a)(2), to substitute NYSDOT maps with USGS maps that will depict the relationship of the proposed transmission system to the overall electrical system;

3) Section 86.3(b)(2), to allow the use of aerial photographs that have not been taken within six months of the filing of the application; and

4) Section 86.4(b), to substitute NYSDOT maps with USGS maps and NOAA nautical charts that will show the location of alternative routes considered by the Applicant.
