NOTICE OF IMPENDING SETTLEMENT NEGOTIATIONS

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Pursuant to 16 NYCRR § 3.9(a) of the Commission’s Rules and Regulations, The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (“KEDNY”) and KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid (“KEDLI”) (collectively, the “Companies”) submit this Notice of Impending Settlement Negotiations in the above-referenced proceedings. The settlement negotiations will cover the Companies’ proposed rates for gas delivery service, as well as other issues raised by the Companies, Department of Public Service Staff (“Staff”) and active parties in their respective filings in these proceedings. In accordance with 16 NYCRR § 3.9(d), the settlement discussions are strictly confidential.


Based on outreach and feedback from Staff and other active parties, the settlement negotiations will begin with an initial settlement discussion on **Wednesday, October 11, 2023, at 2:00 p.m.** The hybrid meeting will be in person at the Department of Public Service office Boardroom, located at 90 Church Street, New York, New York with an option for attendees to attend virtually via Microsoft Teams. Settlement negotiations will continue thereafter as may be necessary and convenient. The location, date, and time of subsequent negotiations will be provided to all parties at a later time.

All parties to these proceedings may participate in the settlement negotiations. The Companies requests that parties affirmatively indicate, by electronic email to Frances Matte (Frances.Matte@nationalgrid.com), whether they intend to participate in settlement discussions.

Parties wishing to participate virtually will be provided Microsoft Teams meeting information, including a dial-in number and/or login information prior to the meeting.

Finally, pursuant to 16 NYCRR 3.9(a)(iii), I certify that I am notifying the Administrative Law Judges in these proceedings and all parties on the active parties list of the pendency of negotiations in a manner that permits reasonable time for preparation.
