requesting an extension until January 9, 2024, to commence the transfer of data to the Integrated Energy Data Resource (IEDR) platform in accordance with the directives set forth in the *Order Addressing Integrated Energy Data Resource Matters* (Order), issued October 13, 2023, in the above proceeding. The filing is currently due December 12, 2023.

In your letter, you state that the Joint Utilities provided a redlined data sharing agreement to the IEDR Administrator, E Source, on November 17, 2023, and subsequently E Source provided its response to the redlined data sharing agreement on December 5, 2023. You add that the Joint Utilities, NYSERDA, and E Source are working collaboratively to resolve differences and finalize the data sharing agreements, but additional time is needed to complete that process. You advise that Department of Public Service staff does not object to your requested extension.

Please be advised that an extension, until January 9, 2024, is granted to the Joint Utilities, NYSERDA, and E Source LLC to commence the transfer of data to the IEDR platform, as directed by the Order. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
