### Circumstances

Lucio stated that it was hired to perform excavation as a subcontractor and was told that all permits were in place. Staff conducted a ticket search for one call notifications at this location and no tickets were found. Regardless, pursuant to 16 NYCRR §753-3.1(a)(1), the entity performing the excavation work is responsible for providing notice of intent to excavate to the one-call notification system. Lucio has no prior

violations, committed to taking corrective action and training, and was cooperative through-out the investigation.

Mitigating Factors to Support a Reduced Penalty

1. Lucio Masonry, Inc. has no history of prior violations.
2. Lucio Masonry, Inc. has committed to take remedial actions to prevent re-occurrence - it has completed a training session given by Dig Safely New York.
3. Lucio Masonry, Inc. was cooperative throughout the investigation and enforcement proceeding.
