PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a virtual procedural conference will be held before Administrative Law Judge Tara A. Kersey on Friday, October 6, 2023, by Webex. The procedural conference will begin at 10:30 a.m.

This conference concerns the petition filed on July 7, 2023, by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (NYSEG or Company), pursuant to Public Service Law §68 and Parts 17 and 21 of New York Codes, Rules and Regulations, seeking an expedited order granting the Company an amendment to its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. NYSEG seeks to exercise its rights, pursuant to existing franchise agreements with the Towns of Romulus and Varick, Seneca County, New York, to provide natural gas service to Seneca Dairy Systems' new galvanizing facility.

The principal purposes of the procedural conference are to identify the parties and major issues, discuss a schedule for the proceeding, address issues related to the service of documents and discovery, and address any other pertinent procedural issues.
