ORES Response to Compliance Filing Package #2 (Tree Clearing)

Dear Jessica Klami and James Muscato:

In accordance with the requirements of Article VIII and its implementing regulations (title 16 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules, and Regulations of the State of New York [16 NYCRR] part 1100), the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (Office or ORES) issued the above-captioned Major Renewable Energy Facility Siting Permit (Permit) to Prattsburgh Wind, LLC (Permittee or Prattsburgh Wind) for a 147 MW Wind Facility on September 24, 2024.

Prattsburgh Wind submitted pre-construction compliance filings on September 9, 2025 (DMM Item Nos. 268-279) and September 15, 2025 (DMM Item No. 281), which the Office recognizes are intended to support a limited Notice to Proceed (NTP) with Phase 2 (Tree Clearing) of facility construction. On January 9, 2026, Prattsburgh Wind submitted updated and additional filings for Phase 2 (Tree Clearing) (DMM Item Nos. 294-296). Subsequently, on April 17, 2026 (DMM Item Nos. 308-310) and June 10, 2026 (DMM Item Nos. 317-318) Prattsburgh Wind submitted updated and additional filings for Phase 2 (Tree Clearing).

The Office has reviewed the above-referenced documents and has prepared the attached approvals, comments, and deficiencies set forth in **Attachment A** to this letter. All deficiencies identified in Attachment A must be satisfactorily addressed in compliance with 16 NYCRR § 1100-10.1(a)(2). The Office reserves the right to provide additional comments and deficiencies and will consider the limited NTP request once all deficiencies have been addressed.
