Dear Joseph Suich:

I received your May 21, 2026 letter, on behalf of the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA), requesting an extension to file its Q1 2026 Metric Report (Q1 Report), pursuant to the Clean Energy Funding Reporting Guidance issued on December 12, 2021, in Case 14-M-0094. The Q1 Report is due May 31, 2026.

You note that the Commission's *Order Modifying New York Green Bank* (Order) issued on January 23, 2026, in the above-captioned proceedings, requires NYSERDA to file a revised New York Green Bank Metrics, Reporting, and Evaluation Reporting Plan (Plan) for Department of Public Service staff (staff) approval by May 23, 2026. You state that NYSERDA is requesting an extension to submit its Q1 Report because you advise that an extension of 30 days after staff approves NYSERDA's Plan will ensure that the Q1 Report is aligned to the 2026 New York Green Bank targets and indicators, as described in the Order.

Based upon the information provided, an extension is granted to New York State Energy Research and Development Authority to file its Q1 Report 30 days after staff approves the Plan. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of these proceedings, and this ruling will be posted on the Department's website.
