Re: Case 18-E-0138: Proceeding on Motion of the Commission Regarding Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment and Infrastructure

Dear Secretary Phillips:

The Indicated Utilities¹ request extensions of time to complete the onsite operational verification visits² and to submit the associated verification report³ required by the Commission’s March 23, 2026 Order Denying Petition and Making Other Findings. As directed, the Indicated Utilities developed a sampling methodology in consultation with Department of Public Service Staff and have commenced onsite verification visits across their respective service territories.⁴ However, the Indicated Utilities have encountered logistical constraints, including travel between geographically dispersed locations that may require customer access to private property and request additional time to support thorough visits. The Indicated Utilities request the extensions in the table below:
