CASE 22-M-0429 - Proceeding to Implement the Utility Thermal Energy Network and Jobs Act.

NOTICE REQUESTING COMMENTS

(Issued July 6, 2023)

On September 15, 2022, the Public Service Commission issued its Order on Developing Thermal Energy Networks Pursuant to the Utility Thermal Energy Network and Jobs Act (Order) in the above-captioned case. As explained in the Order, the Utility Thermal Energy Network and Jobs Act, which took effect on July 5, 2022, requires each of the seven largest gas, electric, or combination gas and electric utilities to submit at least one and as many as five proposed thermal energy projects.¹ The Utilities submitted preliminary pilot project filings on October 7, 2022, and, in accordance with the stepped regulatory approach articulated in the Order, the Utilities submitted revised pilot project filings by January 9, 2023.² To date, all of the Utilities have complied with their required filings. On June 30, 2023, Central Hudson filed its Thermal Energy Network Supplemental Plan Update, containing additional details regarding its proposed pilot project.

¹ The Order identified the "seven largest" utilities by applying the "annual intrastate gross operating revenue of the corporation" as used in Public Service Law (PSL) §25-a and §66(29)(a). Accordingly, as used herein, "Utilities" refers to and pilot project requirements apply to: Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc., New York State Electric and Gas Corporation, Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation, National Grid USA, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation (Central Hudson), and National Fuel Gas Distribution Company.
