Re: Cases 25-E-0072 and 25-G-0073 Consolidated Edison, New York Rate Cases


Dear Secretary Phillips and Administrative Law Judges Costello, Kersey and Planty:

The Westchester Municipal Consortium (“WMC”), consisting of forty municipalities within Westchester County, submits this letter in lieu of a post-hearing brief on the Joint Proposal filed in the above-referenced proceedings. The evidentiary hearing held on December 3, 2025 did not change the position of WMC as set forth in our Comments on the Joint Proposal previously submitted.

We would point out the responses of Con Edison to certain WMC Information Requests were admitted into evidence as exhibits to assist the Commission in better understanding the respective costs of distributing electricity through an Underground Grid Network compared to an Overhead Radial System (Exhibit 1237a.) as well as the relative levels of investment in New York City and Westchester County (Exhibit 1237b). These two issues are addressed in the Joint Proposal through providing data in conjunction with the next ECOS study and annual meetings on investments with WMC.

In recognition of the material reduction of the proposed increases that brings the results substantially closer to the rate of inflation and the provisions within the JP addressing Westchester County issues, WMC is not opposing the Joint Proposal. To avoid the impact of rate compression, WMC requests that the Commission consider the JP as soon as practical.
