CASE 25-T-0040 - Petition of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid for an Amendment to a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need Issued to Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation in Case 70137.

NOTICE SOLICITING COMMENTS

(Issued February 4, 2025)

On August 8, 1983, the Public Service Commission (Commission) granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate)¹ that authorized the construction and operation of a double-circuit 115 kV transmission line from the existing Colton Substation in the Town of Pierrepont to Tower Number 26 in the Town of Massena. In a petition filed on January 10, 2025 (Amendment Petition), pursuant to Public Service Law Section 122(4), Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid requests approval to amend the Certificate. If approval is granted, Certificate Condition 7 would be modified from specifying the use of wood poles to allowing for the use of double-circuit, single-pole, galvanized steel structures. The existing wood poles are now in need of replacement.
