Vistra Corp. (“Vistra”) respectfully requests that the New York State Public Service Commission rule on the above-referenced petition, which was filed on June 16, 2025, at its October 16 session. As demonstrated in the petition, Vistra owns and operates approximately 43,000 MW of electric generation in New York and across the country reliably and efficiently and has the requisite financial strength and experience to own and operate the Beaver Falls and Syracuse facilities. A ruling at the October 16 session will allow Vistra to begin operating the facilities as soon as possible to maintain their long-standing stability and reliability.
